Set up will be on Saturday October 15 starting at 12pm. The course will be set. Jumpers will go on Saturday starting at 2pm. We don't need to hire a judge for Saturday for the jumpers because two of us (professional members) can do it ourselves. The ring will open at 4pm for paid ticketed schooling for the horses showing on Sunday. There will be no warm up classes on Sunday. Flatting will be allowed on Sunday morning.

The next item for discussion was the Finals prizes. Annette asked her people for ideas: embroidered saddle pads, bed blankets, gloves, bucket of horse supplies, wine (which was liked but voted down due to insurance issues), horse patterned umbrella, monogrammed chairs, knee socks, boot polishing kits, embroidered visors, horse treats. The buckets were chosen. Large blue bucket for Champion with the WHVPHA label on it and budget of \$75. Smaller red bucket with WHVPHA label with \$50 budget for Reserve Champion. It was also suggested to tailor the buckets to adults and children.

The next item for discussion were the Year End Banquet Awards. Backpacks and duffels were chosen.
