Continuing Equine Education Scholarship:

This scholarship is open to all college WHVPHA members who have shown an interest and good sportsmanship in any aspect of the horse industry. A candidate may apply for this scholarship to help with their equine education during college. The scholarship must be used for Lessons, showing or College IHSA fees. Candidate maybe nominated by another WHVPHA member.

The amount of the scholarship will be up to \$500. More than one scholarship maybe awarded during a calendar year. This award is to be used by a College attendee for riding, lessons with a professional of their choice, clinics, educational seminars, betterment of the rider or any other activity that the Scholarship Committee feels qualifies.

To qualify for a scholarship a candidate must:

1. Have been a member in good standing for at least one calendar year.
2. Submit an application no later than April 30th of each year. A completed packet must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee.
3. Write an essay, approximately 500 words, on "What is the difference between riding during college and as a junior?"
4. Submit a resume of your equine experience and what the funds will be used for. Please indicate the amount requested, if necessary.
5. Provide one letter of recommendation showing how the candidate has clearly demonstrated they are an outstanding sportsman and an asset to the horse community.
